

Yellow "No Step" are used on white control surfaces while Black "No Steps" are used on control surfaces of overall gray aircraft.







Phoenix missile pallets are painted the underside color of the F-14's in any particular squadron. If the Squadron has a mix of Lt. Gull Gray and White aircraft along with overall

Lt. Gull Gray aircraft you may see Gray missile pallets on Gray/White aircraft and White missile pallets on overall Gray aircraft.

Drawings depict an F-14 wearing the Gull Gray/White USN Color Scheme. All Navy Fighter Aircraft are going to low visability markings and this includes the removal of the White undersurfaces and control surfaces. The Gray carried on F-14's is Lt. Gull Gray FS 36440. This color has a slight gloss sheen to it. Undersurface White is FS 27875. Leading edges on all flying surfaces are Natural Metal.

Cockpit Interior: Dark Green FS 36231 This includes floor, bulkheads, side panels, instrument panels, seat frames and canopy inside bracing. Ejection Seat:

Dark Gull Gray FS 36231: seat frame Dark Green FS 34079: Parachute rack and seat

cushion.

Black FS 17038: Headrest and seat rails

Yellow FS 33538: Face curtain handles (note - face

curtain handles have Black stripes)

Wheel Wells, Door Insides and Wheel Struts: Gloss White FS 27875: Interior of wheel wells,

inside of gear doors, wheel struts, wheel hubs, interior of engine intakes and access panels.


Gloss Insignia Red FS 31136: Edges on all landing gear doors Natural Metal: Oleo struts, lips on intakes and panel infront

of gun.
