and under wing tips

Under Surfaces: RLM 76 Light Blue; note Red primer spots on landing gear door bolts

Prop & Spinner: RLM 70 Black-Green; spinner: RLM 04 Yellow National Insignia: Wings: Upper 910 mm crosses; Lower: 900 mm crosses

Fuselage: 800 mm crosses; 420 mm Hakenkreuz

Stencilling: Factory standard; W.Nr. 7336 on top of fin; name 'Anni' in Red under wind screen

Colors: Upper Surfaces: RLM 70 Black-Green segments over weathered White winter camouflage

RLM 04 Yellow under cowling, cowl ring, spinner, under wing tips and lower portion of rudder

Under Surfaces: RLM 76 Light Blue

Prop & Spinner: RLM 70 Black-Green; spinner: RLM 04 Yellow

National Insignia: Wings: Upper 910 mm crosses; Lower: 900 mm crosses

Fuselage: 800 mm crosses; 420 mm Hakenkreuz

Stencilling: Factory standard over painted; Note heavy oil streaks on engine cowling; Yellow '6' partially over sprayed with RLM 70 Black-Green

Notable features: Lower portion of landing gear door removed to avoid mud clogging the wheels

Colors: Upper Surfaces: Undocumented Medium Green and RLM 70 Black-Green segments over weathered White winter camouflage; Black exhaust panel

Under Surfaces: RLM 76 Light Blue

Prop & Spinner: RLM 70 Black-Green; Spinner: White

National Insignia: Wings: Upper 910 mm crosses; Lower: 900 mm crosses

Fuselage: 800 mm crosses; 420 mm Hakenkreuz

Stencilling: Factory standard overpainted
