



USN Post-WWII Eastern TBM-3 Avengers





White 2: VU-5 TBM-3U, BuNo 85594, during February of 1952 with Sea Blue fuselage, Orange-Yellow wings and tail, and Insignia Ried wing bands, rudder, and possible horizontal tail tips. Black propeller with 4-inch yellow tips. Fuselage national insignia appears to have a blue surround, though it might not have. A Glossy Insignia White AN/ASP-4 radar pod was carried under the right wing. A radar pod may be borrowed from the Monogram P-38 Lightning kit. TBM-3Us were supposed to have had all armor and armament removed as they were used as utility aircraft, however, the turret, sans machine gun, was installed. We presume the ventral machine gun was removed and the windows faired over. Unlike some TBM-3Us, this aircraft has an internal tailhook. Unknown if additional rear fuselage heater scoops and exhaust (depicted) were present. Reference: A - 74.



White 22: VS-21 TBM-3E, BuNo 85970, in overall Sea Blue while serving aboard the USS Badoeng Strait (CVE-116) during April of 1952. This Avenger was one of the few remaining USN carrier-based Avengers that was not modified for Anti-Submarine Warfare or Carrier-On-Board Delivery (COD) transport duties. Black propeller with 4-inch yellow tips. Additional rear fuselage heater scoops and exhaust; the right exhaust (above the star-and-bar) being a light color. Probable faired ventral windows. Probable Glossy Insignia White AN/ASP-4 radar pod under right wing. White 22 (4) may not have been applied. Reference: B - 55.
