Former Japanese Navy Scout Sea Plane



In the early morning of December 7, 1941, "JAKE" were catapulted from cruisers Chikuma, Kinugasa and Tone, of the Combined Fleet, to scout and gather the information on the disposition of the U.S. Fleet in Pearl Harbor. This scouting performance merited a great contribution in the attack of Pearl Harbor.

In December 1940, formally replacing the Type-94 Scout Sea Plane, they were assigned to the front line service. Among the many types of sea planes this Type-Zero 3 seats scout sea plane produced in great quantity and had played a great part throughout the Great War, as a scout plane. From the beginning of the War, she was assigned with the tactical force in the South and with the naval operation up to the Aleutian island.

Other than for scouting, she was also used for patrol, attack, transportation, rescue and escort purpose. 1400 planes, of these types, was mas produced up to the end of the War: (1) Type-11.... Serviced in December 1940, Floats supported by 4 struts and reinforced with tension wire. (2) Type-11A.... Serviced in 1944, No.6 Radio Apparatus Type 4 was installed, floats supported with 8 struts. (3) Type-11B....Serviced in 1944, radar antenna installed on the main wing and fuselage, floats supported with 8 struts.







Dark Green, Bottom Surface... Light Grey, Propeller Front

and Back Surface...Dark Green, Propeller Tip...1 Yellow

Stripe, Spinner... Same color as Fuselage, Red or White.

Green + Yellow + Black (Latter Part of World War II) Green + Yellow + Blue + Black






