I-16 (TsKB-12) - a Soviet single-engine monoplane fighter of the 1930s, created at the Central Design Bureau by a team led by aircraft designer Nikolai Polikarpov. One of the world's first mass-produced monoplane fighters with retractable landing gear in flight. The aircraft had a mixed design. The serial production of the aircraft, originally with the M-22 engine, started in 1934, and really unfolded only the next year. In 1935, it became possible to install M-25 engines on the aircraft, which were a Soviet copy of the American Wright-Cyclone R-1820 F-3. The production of these engines was launched at the newly built aircraft factory No.19 in Perm. In 1935, using often American parts, the plant produced 660 M-25 engines. Some of these engines were intended for the I-16. In general, this aircraft was very reminiscent of the third prototype with the Wright-Cyclone R-1820 F-3.

The Finnish Air force took several damaged I-16 as trophies. One of the planes restored to flying condition, was a Type 5 that had previously served in the 11th Fighter Aviation Regiment of the Baltic Fleet Air Force and had been used as a ground attack aircraft, equipped with six rockets under its wings. In the Finnish Air Force, the aircraft served from August 1, 1942, to June 22, 1943, and later was placed in storage.
